

Exit Slips

What is an Exit Slip?

- Writing at the close of the class period, even in brief formats , can help students reflect on what they have learned and , in a sense, help prepare their minds for continued learning on the topic
- They are quick and easy
- Students spend several minutes jotting down their thoughts about the lesson (can respond to a prompt)
- Show the students' thinking process
- No right or wrong answers

Example prompts:

- The three most important things I learned today are...
- Today I changed my mind about...
- What I would like to tell someone else about what I learned today is...
- Two questions I have about what we did in class today are..
- I am confused about...
- What I would like to learn next is..
- The thing that helped me pay attention most today was...
- The thing that helped me understand most today was...
- Something that did not help me learn in class today was...

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
