What is Reading Actively?

- Reading actively is responding to a text and being an active participant in the reading process

What is the point of Reading Actively?

- Reading actively helps students become better readers. It leads to a better understanding of a particular text, and it helps students find the Main Idea

What to do when Reading Actively:

- Read the questions you need to answer first
- Don't Rush when you are reading
- Mark important parts of the text as you read and highlight
- Ask yourself questions if you are confused
- Clarify what you have learned

How to Read Actively:

- Use a pen or highlighter to underline important parts of the text, vocabulary words, topic sentences, and supporting details
- Write down any questions you have in the margins
- Summarize the Main Idea
