## Hero Poem

---

The hero poem describes a person rather than an image or feeling though it includes images and feelings.

### Pattern

- Line 1: A person you admire
- Line 2: Three words to describe the person
- Line 3: Place, group, or activity identified with the person
- Line 4: Three action words (*-ing* words) for the person
- Line 5: When or where the actions take place
- Line 6: Thoughts or feelings about the person
