

## Reading Assignments



Are you an artist?

Pick a scene from your book and illustrate it using any artistic medium, you can draw, paint, sketch, sculpt, or make a collage. Be creative, and write a caption explaining which scene you've depicted and why.

Are you a letter writer?

Type a thoughtful letter to the author of your book. Explain why you like/dislike the novel, what you have learned from reading it and ask at least two good questions you have about the book.

Are you a poet/songwriter?

Write a poem or song about the book you have read. The poem/song can focus on any event or character. Be sure to let the audience know how much time and effort you put forth on this assignment, by sharing your poem/song with the class.

Are you a DJ?

Make a soundtrack on a CD or tape that would connect to your novel's themes. This soundtrack should include appropriate songs for the classroom setting and the CD must include a CD jacket, which will contain the title of the song, the performer, and a brief explanation of how the song relates to the novel.

Are you an actor?

Pick a scene from your book and perform it in front of the class. Before acting it out, please explain the scene to the class so we know what to expect. Make sure you stay in character and "ACT!" You must come in appropriate attire and we must believe that you are the character.

Are you a director?

Come into class and show us movie poster created with the book in mind. Write out movie trailer and explain how the pictures on the movie poster relates to the story. You want us to pay 9.00 to see the book turn movie, so test out your marketing skills.
