This painting is on the wall of the Tomb of Sennedjem. Records show that the ancient Egyptian artisan, Sennedjem, lived in Deir el-Medina on the west bank of the Nile, opposite Thebes, during the reigns of Seti I and Ramesses II. He was buried along with his wife, Iy-neferti, and family in a tomb in the village necropolis. His tomb was discovered January 31, 1886. Carefully examine this painting.
