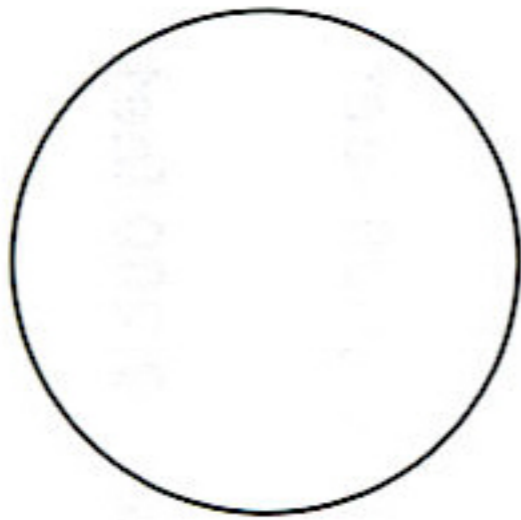
Annual Precipitation (in inches)

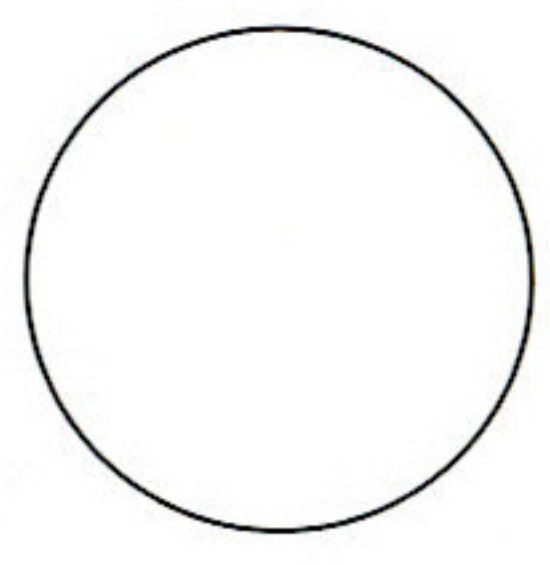
